I came to know Mr.K.Sriram, couple of years prior to launch of BAI, Mysore. First impression is the best impression and it proved right, once he involved himself in the formative stages of BAI. I have travelled with him more than 50 times for conferences, seminars, MC & GC meeting. It has been highly educative for both of us. He stumped everybody with a googly in one of the managing committee meetings by presenting a PPT about his thinking on BAI and also spoke at length about his vision. Most people do not know that breaking rocks and crushing stone is a child's play for Sriram, who is always cool as a cucumber. A real CAT with explosives he is one of the youngest to have a license. Some really critical projects in blasting was done by him and that included approach into KRS Dam, sensitive areas of Varuna canal near Mysore and the National Highway approaches near Chitradurga involving rock cutting of an entire hill.

He keeps himself fit, by working till 6pm only and spending quality time with family and friends, avoiding partying and late nights. On lessons learnt from his experience, he says in his inimitable style, "Always under promise and over deliver. 'Cash is the King', always look towards doing things that is within your reach and that which brings positive cash flows. Never run away from a problem, face it with courage. Never compromise on time with family, it is priceless." He is a highly spiritual person. Somewhere he over did it, and there was a small derailment of business. Once he realised it he came back on track with a bang.

His year as a chairman was a great success. He started MYREALTY exhibition for the first time, organized Chinnara Dasara for the first time, which was lesson for the government to organize this every year. Facilitated 10 episodes of weekly radio program on construction. He organized for top speakers like Jaipal Reddy, Captain Gopinath, Alex Brunner, Ashok Kheny to name a few.

He is the founder of CREDAI, Mysore and CREDAI Karnataka by working as its Honorary Secretary; currently Vice-President, CREDAI, Karnataka and also member of its National GB. Founder of IGBC, Mysore and a member of its National Executive; currently Chairman of the committee to draft the "Green Construction Code", recently appointed as Chairman of the "National Green skills commission". involved in IFWAPCA, was the co-chair of he 40th IFWAPCA Convention. He has been the Head of Infrastructure Panel, CII Mysore zone.

His vision on BAI Mysore: "It should go on to become the fulcrum of construction activity in the area. We should be a big knowledge sharing platform hosting a fairly big secretariat. Several services connected with our industry like material testing, property management services, property search services etc should be available and all this can be a big revenue earner to maintain top class talent in the secretariat. Activities for the members should be varied and interesting, with several sub committees working towards advocacy and policy. Several organizations like the American Concrete Institute, Concrete Society UK are so highly reputed and respected that their sub committees write the codes and set about policy. We should endeavour to get there. We should have an excellent training facility to "Train the Trainer" to Act as a force multiplier for our mega institute training program. Our data collection system should be world class to enable us to have information on our finger tips. Our research division should emanate from here.

We should have a series of publications and patents. Sounds like a dream but what can I do, I am a hopeless optimist!!"

This is what our dear Sriram is. who is really mover, shaker, shaper of BAI.



From 2013 to 2020, writer Paul Salopek is recreating the epic journey on foot of 21,000-mile odyssey began in humankind's

birthplace Ethiopia and will end seven years later at the tip of South America's Tierra del Fuego, where our forebears ran out of horizon. Along the way he is engaging with the major stories of our time — from climate change to technological innovation, from mass migration to cultural survival — by walking alongside the people who inhabit these headlines every day. Moving at the slow beat of his footsteps, Paul is also seeking the quieter, hidden stories of people who rarely make the news.

Every 100 miles (160 km) Paul is pausing to tend the campfire of our shared humanity by recording a narrative Milestone consisting of photographs of the ground and sky, ambient sound at that location, and a brief, standardized interview with the nearest person. Paul's walk is shared in real time with thousands of schoolchildren across the world. Paul's dispatches are stories told in words and pictures, mainly stills but also video and periodically audio. They vary in length from a short paragraph to long-form reportage of several thousand words. These stories are translated in many languages (French, Spain, Hebrew, Magyar, Roman, Italian, Arabic and Kannada) throughout the world. So far sixty short stories are received which has to be translated.

Our own Mr. B.S.Dinesh was selected to translate to Kannada by National Geographic Society. The short stories translated to Kannada will be sent to National Geographic Society for publication in digital media. We the builders are proud to have Mr.B.S.Dinesh doing the job.
