
Apart from his business, he has great passion for photography. Mr. Dinesh is a wildlife photographer, freelance journalist, writer and translator. He is an avid traveller.

Wildlife photography has always been his passion. He has travelled through the forests of central, south and north eastern India to experience wilderness. He has also travelled to Serengeti and Ngorongoro National Parks of Tanzania.

His photographs have won awards in wildlife photography competitions held by Mysore Zoo, a 2nd prize in 2011 and 1st prize in the year 2013, both in the open category. His photographs were published in the editions of the book "Mammals of South Asia".

Along the way, he also became a freelance journalist, having been inspired by Poorna Chandra Tejaswi, his favourite and most admired writer. He writes about his stories in the wilderness and travelogues in the Haadu-paadu section of Andolana newspaper. He is also a special Correspondent of the same news paper. In 2015, he and his daughter Eeshani travelled by themselves in the Ladakh region on a Royal Enfield, the travelogue of which he covered as a column with 13 episodes in Andolana. Ever since camera, book and pen have been his second family.

He is now translating a National Geographic Sponsored project, Pulitzer Prizewinning journalist Paul Salopek's "Out of Eden Walk" into kannada. It is an epic journey of 34,000 Km across three continents in a span of 7 years by walk. Started on January 10th 2013 from Ethiopia, this project is supported by KNIGHT FOUNDATION and PULITZER CENTER FOR CRISIS REPORTING. Kannada is the only Indian language into which this amazing travelogue is being translated. And it is a matter of pride that Mr. Dinesh is the only Indian person who has been selected by National Geographic Society along with Arabic, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Georgian, Hungarian, Polish, French and Hebrew nationals. He quotes "I am really proud to say that my profile has been featured in the National Geographic Website".

### WORLD ENVIRONMENT MONTH INAUGURATION



Inaugural function of World environment month celebration on 5th June 2019 was a wonderful start indeed. The speakers are worth hearing about their work in their respective area of expertise. Prof. Sindhu Radhakrishna spoke about climate change. What these scientist find with the available data is that they have analysed that for every 1.5 million years there is an ice age regularly.

The factors affecting the climate change is mainly due to emission of  $\mathbf{Co_2}$  in the present years, logging of trees, mining and many more. The main reason for  $\mathbf{Co_2}$  emission is use of fossil fuel, to reduce this emission we may have to use solar energy or wind energy or avoid use of vehicles whenever possible.

The effects of  $Co_2$  makes the green house effect where in it makes the atmosphere warmer. When the atmosphere gets warmer ice glaziers melts resulting in rise of mean sea level, which results in getting some human habitat getting submerged causing great loss to the man kind. The  $Co_2$  emission also pollute the atmosphere in the form of air pollution, causing health related problems to the living beings.

The rise in temperature cause los of flora & fauna due difficulties in adaptability to the hot climate. This is the reason why some plants & animals became extinct, this is a dangerous situation.

The cause for the above is human beings. Use of natural resources extensively for developments and comforts, to mitigate the effect of global warming, do plant trees in large numbers and nurture it to grow, use less energy, use less resources and so on.

These were some of the points Prof. Sindhu Radhakrishna envisaged in her presentation on the days talk, thanks to the organisers.

Next came the lake man Sri Anand Malligawad presented his way of rejuvenating the lakes in Bengaluru. He is a man committed to revive 45 lakes by 2025. He use to enjoy free time in his child hood days by swimming and playing near a lake in his native place.

One day near his home in Bengaluru he visited the lake Kyalasanahalli, it was dying with silt and pollution he thought of cleaning & why it is so polluted. His view is the present generation of ladies are not going to lakes for doing the cultural rituals' which earlier generation were doing in the form of puja etc. Children are avoiding swimming in the near by lakes, water is not used for daily usage, this resulted in the neglect of lakes. So he thought of involving the local

population to revive the lake. He visited nearly 450 houses and mobilised the people to create the awareness not to spoil the lake further by not dumping waste into the lake .

He attended the meetings how to protect the lakes, with his determined mind he approached the authority to get the permission to revive the lake Kyalasanahalli. With the help of the company where he worked earlier, to use the CSR fund of the company to revive the Kylasanahalli lake, with an area of 36 acres with 95 lakhs budget. He completed this in a record time of 45 days, with 4 earth moving equipments, he excavated a record quantity of 4.6 lakh cum of earth in 12 days. He could achieve this by motivating men involved in the work. He has planted 23 varieties of plants 6000 in nos. in one day, with the active participation of volunteers of an NGO. Now the lake is full, if you go to Bangalore visit it.

He revived the Vabasandra lake without discharging even a litre of water which existed at the time of rejuvenation this lake was revived in a span of 52 days with 95 lakhs budget. He revived Gavi lake in a span of 15 days with Rs. 15 lakhs, this is the first lake in the world which was funded by the donors from all the corners of the globe. For right cause there is no dearth of funds . If the 6 crore people of this state make mind in contributing Rs.1 per day, with in few years we can revive all the lake in the state. He has vast knowledge of behaviour of lakes. His way of presentation was unique, his piece of advice is protect the lakes & trees around your community, use rainwater harvesting, solar energy & do not pollute any source of resources.


