SHILPI INTERNSHIP PROGRAM



Shilpi Internship Program for Engineering students was Inaugurated on 11th July at MBCT Auditorium at 11am.

Mr. S. Prakash, Chairman ACCE (I), Mysore was the Chief Guest and Mr. B.R. Badarinath, Past Chairman of BAI Mysore, was the Guest of Honour. Shilpi Co-ordinator Mr. V. Srinath welcomed the gathering. BAI Mysore Chairman Mr. B.S. Dinesh spoke about BAI and its activities. Hon. Secretary Mr. R. Raghunath introduced Guest of Honour Mr. Badarinath. Mr. Udai Kumar introduced Chief Guest to the gathering.

In their addresses both Mr. Badarinath and Mr. Prakash emphasized about the importance of internship,

advised them to be attentive and to acquire maximum knowledge as it is a golden opportunity for them. Mr. Ramesh Rao, the master of ceremony, did a commendable job. Mr. A. Dinesh proposed the vote of thanks. Around 190 students from different engineering colleges registered and attended the program. It is noteworthy that students from different places like Sullya, Tiptoor, KGF, K.R. Pete, Mandya, and seven engineering colleges from Mysuru enrolled for the internship.

This shows their confidence, eagerness and inclination to do internship through BAI Mysore. We are thankful to Spoorthi President and members who helped us in registration work. Faculties from different engineering colleges attended the inaugural. The program was followed by lunch. The students were divided into 13 groups which were named after different components of building, like roof, lintel, column etc. Each Shilpi coordinator was given responsibility of two groups.

We identified around 15 sites belonging to our own members and made each group visit different sites on rotation basis. The idea behind this was, students would come across different stages and types of construction in different sites. On 15th, Team Shilpi took all the internship students to Kadakola under the guidance of Mr. Deepak to visit a site wherein cold storage and dry storage work was going on. Also, they visited an automated cement block brick industry. More than 150 students attended this program in spite of rain and they were very happy about

this industrial visit.

Next day on 16th we had a technical session at our MBCT auditorium from 10:30am to 1:30pm. The first session was on road works and it was handled by engineer Mr. Guruprasad from quality control, PWD. He gave a one hour PPT presentation about execution of road works. Another retired Chief Engineer Mr. Trimbak T.P. spoke about irrigation projects with PPT presentation. In between these two technical sessions, the much acclaimed international personality trainer Mr. Chetan Ram spoke to students about personality development and communication skills for almost 75 minutes. 


