PRODUCT PRESENTATION BY SARALA INDUSTRIES



n 27th of September 2019, Builders' Association of India, Mysore Centre, had organized a Product Presentation in association with M/s Sarala Industries at MBCT Board room. The programme started with a welcome address by BAI Mysore Centre Chairman Mr. B.S. Dinesha. The programme included a technical talk with Power Point Presentation on Introduction to Offshore Drilling by Er. Jeevaraj Dasanna, Partner, M/s Sarala Industries. Introduction of speaker Mr. Jeevaraj Dasanna was done by Mr. H. S. Deepak, a member of our Centre. The presentation included introduction to fossil fuels and their formation. It also covered the procedure involved in offshore drilling. Besides this, there was focus on the different types of rigs available in the world to carry out drilling to pump out crude oil onto the earth's surface.



The crude oil collected from different locations are transported to refinery unit through sea tankers. At refinery unit the crude oil is refined to different petroleum products and then the finished products are sold at international market generating revenue for that particular country. Finally he said this oil is also called as black gold.

Further in the second session, a Power Point presentation on Concrete Block Product of Sarala Industries was made by a representative of the company. The presentation emphasised the need for concrete block masonry, as it is economical and speeds up construction. After a brief introduction about the company, he spoke about procedure involved in manufacturing of different concrete Products. The video depicted how the entire plant is



owned and managed by Engineers by adopting two unique technology called as Columbia Vibration Technology for compression and Humidifier Technology for curing purposes which makes their product superior in strength and finishing. To wind up, the representative spoke about the importance of handling and delivery of their product.

The Vote of thanks was proposed by Mr. R Raghunath, Honorary Secretary BAI, Mysore Centre and was followed by fellowship and delicious dinner.





TURKISH TALES



Delighted to share our experiences in the 11day trip to Turkey. It was completely a new experience as we were visiting an Islamic country. This trip began on 7th October 2019. It was a journey of eleven hours to Istanbul with a stopover in Bahrain and we landed in Istanbul on 8th evening and subsequently moved to our hotel. On the way to dinner at an Indian restaurant, we explored Taksim Square with its Republic monument which has a nightlife entertainment, shopping and dining area.

Cappadocia is situated in Central Turkey and is a geological oddity of honeycombed hills & towering boulders of other worldly beauty. It was a wonderful sight to behold and some of us who went on a ride in the hot air balloons had a fairy tale experience. It was worth braving the chill weather early in the morning. It was an amazing experience to visit Derinkuyu the underground city and we were spellbound by its unique Architecture. In the evening we were entertained with a Turkish belly dancing show.

On 11th October, we visited Goreme open air museum, monk's valley, pottery and ceramic workshop. Some shopped there for wonderful art pieces & tea sets. The next day 12th October, after breakfast we reached Antalya by coach via Konya Malvana Mausoleum, tile museum and on reaching Antalya visited Archeological museum. A special dinner was arranged at Hotel Su from Thomas cook to celebrate my Birthday. It was indeed overwhelming and very surprising to me.

On 13th October sunday, exploring Antalya was our goal. Antalya is a Turkish resort city with a Yacht filled old harbor and beaches flanked by large hotels. Antalya is known for its nightlife, the city was buzzing with dance and music at night which we all enjoyed to the fullest.

We shopped for zultanite stone which is a gem stone and has seven different color tones according to the light that is dedicated to Ottoman Sultan's name. We visited Duden

waterfalls which is a group of waterfalls formed by recycled station water and drops off a rocky cliff directly into the Mediterranean Sea.

On 14th October, we experienced a bumpy Jeep safari in the middle of Taurus Mountains. Visited a traditional village house and enjoyed an authentic lunch at a local

On Tuesday morning started off for a visit to picture sque ruins of Hierapolis (very sunny place where many movie scenes and songs of Indian movies have been shot). It was an ancient Greek city located in south western Antolia. Later we headed to the Cotton Castle-Pammukale where we found huge deposits of carbonate mineral left by the flowing water where many of our friends took a dip. After having lunch, we left for Kusadasi. It was a beautiful resort town on the western Aegean. We visited Ephesus which was an ancient Greek city. Curetes street which was once a bustling busy street with shops on either side now lies in ruins. We also visited the Temple of Artemis also known as temple of Diana, a local form of Greek Goddess. We had a glimpse of the Turkish village and tried out some local delicacies.


